Proof of Notice having been furnished, the Public Hearing on Local Law # 1 of 2015 was called to order at 6:34pm by Supervisor Walter. He then read the following list of roads that are to be opened to snowmobiles: Pulaski Street – from NYS 13 to Co Rt 52; Railroad Street – from NYS 13 to Co Rt 22; River Road; Rome Road; Cemetery Street – from NYS 13 to Co Rt 52; So. Albion Road – from Cemetery Street to 1/10 mile south of NYS 13.

The following person(s) spoke in favor of or against the proposed local law:

- 1) Mr. Bryan Myers asked if there was a set time the snowmobiles were allowed on the roads. Supervisor Walter stated that the board could make any restrictions to the local law once it passes. This would be under Section 5: Restrictions in the proposed local law.
- 2) Mr. Neal Braley stated that Bridge Street (aka...County Route 52) wasn't on the list of roads. Supervisor Walter stated it was a County road, and the County would have to open it.
- 3) Councilman Mattison stated the town could not stop snowmobiles from crossing a road. Supervisor Walter stated that the NYS Recreational Law dictates that all snowmobiles must stop and abide by the NYS Traffic Laws.
- 4) Councilman Reff asked about the cost of the signs and who was going to foot the bill. Supervisor Walter stated he had nothing on that issue yet.
- 5) Councilman Mattison asked what the start/stop dates would be. Small discussion on this topic.
- 6) Mr. Neal Braley asked what all started this...the opening of the roads and the proposed local law. Supervisor Walter stated that it was the Tail-Water Lodge.

**Motion made by Councilman Hilton seconded by Councilman Reff to end the hearing. Motion carried. Adopted (4-0) Supervisor Walter – aye: Councilman Reff – aye: Councilman Hilton – aye: Councilman Mattison – aye.**

All person(s) desiring to be heard, having been heard, the Hearing was terminated at 7:48pm by Supervisor Walter.
