Supervisor Walter called the workshop to order at 6:01pm.

Supervisor Walter stated that the 2018 Tentative Budget would have a 1.08% change from the 2017 Adopted Budget; which is well under the Tax Cap of 1.62%.

The Board then went over only those appropriation accounts that had any increases/decreases in them.

Judge Allen stated that his request for a raise of his Clerk and himself was not put in the tentative budget. After some discussion the Board agreed to the request.

Supervisor Walter received a letter from Chief Holcomb asking for a 2% raise in the Fire Contract. The Board talked it over and all agreed to deny the request.

Supervisor Walter stated that he had received a check for \$129,000 resulting from the merger with the Reynolds stock. The Board agreed that this money would be put into the general fund; building repair appropriation account and a new community improvement appropriation account.

Supervisor Walter called the workshop to a close at 7:36pm.
